Effective September 2002 Sioux Chief Manufacturing will go to the new identification marking as shown above.

- Sioux Chief PEX crimp rings are made to the ASTM F1807 Standard and are intended for use with PEX crimp insert fittings made to the ASTM F1807 and CSA B137.5 Standards.
- New identification marking meets all code requirements for IPC and UPC model codes and all codes that allow the use of PEX insert crimp fittings.
- The old all-black marking of PEX crimp rings has never been a requirement of any product standard or plumbing code. Black marking of PEX rings has always been done voluntarily by the manufacturer to simply identify and distinguish PEX rings from the old plain-copper PB rings used in the past. Sioux Chief will now continue to identify our PEX rings with the new black marking shown above.
